

Dear Friends and Neighbors;

Think for a moment; what would you do if you or a family member were home-bound and unable to prepare food for yourself? What if you were isolated and had no regular contact with the community? Who would be there to check in on you or your loved ones? If you think these questions aren't relevant in our community, think again.

Blue Ledge Meals on Wheels was founded in 2007 to address these issues in Amherst County. Monday through Friday volunteers pick up hot, nutritious meals and deliver them to the home-bound elderly or disabled in our community. Our volunteers take a moment to chat with clients and offer them a smile and conversation. They leave them with reassurance that someone will be by each weekday to check on them. We do not leave meals on a doorstep; we have procedures in place to assure that our clients are well and accounted for. Our volunteers spend 30-60 minutes on a route, delivering the food and taking time to visit with the clients.

Blue Ledge is a non-profit, 100% volunteer organization. While some of our funding comes from grants and client payments, the majority of our budget relies on donations from businesses and individuals like you! Being an all-volunteer organization allows us to use the bulk of our funds to go directly to feeding clients.

Blue Ledge is blessed to have 9 local churches who prepare meals for us several days a month. These churches donate the food and time to the Meals on Wheels program as part of their community ministry and outreach. The only cost to Blue Ledge for these meals is the cost of the containers we provide to portion and deliver the meals. We also are partnered with local restaurants and food service groups in the area who prepare the meals for our clients the rest of the month.
